WACS Membership Registration

We are ready for the 2022-2023 school year! Registrations are due in the WACS office by October 1. There are three forms that must be submitted electronically via email (AACS Membership Form) or by using the online links (WACS Membership Registration Form and the WACS School Contacts Information). Please contact the WACS office if you need assistance with the forms.

The ability to pay for your membership fees with a credit card or Paypal account is again available. When you submit the WACS Membership Registration

Form, it will take you to a Paypal screen where you will choose to checkout as a guest, then you can choose to use a Paypal account or a credit card to pay your registration fees. If you prefer to send a check, it needs to arrive in the WACS office by October 1. Registrations and fees not submitted by October 1 will incur a late fee.

Registration fees are now on a graduated scale based on your school size. This registration fee gives your school and students all the benefits of being a WACS member as well as includes your



registration with AACS. The WACS board is also encouraging each school to give \$10 per student and faculty member to help us support Wisconsin Family Council, our legislative representatives, who lobby on our behalf in Madison. However, support of any amount is appreciated.
