LOCATION: JustAGame Fieldhouse, 200 LaCrosse Street, Wisconsin Dells

NOTES:

- Each basketball team will get to play 4 games on Friday.
- The tipoff is set to start at 9:00 a.m. and the last games will be at 6:00 p.m. See separate schedule for individual game times and rules for the classic.
- Please plan to provide your own scorebook for your games. The first team on the schedule will be the official scorekeeper and the home team. The second team on the schedule will need to help with the scoreboard.
- There will be no awards, so teams are free to leave after their last scheduled game.
- Please bring your own warm-up balls.
- Girls' teams will be able to start warmups at 8:30 a.m. on the court they will be playing on.
- Boys' teams will warm up on a 5th court that has four baskets. These are the assigned times:
 - 9:00 a.m. - Academy of Excellence, Bay City, Calvary Baptist, Utica Christian, and Waupaca Christian
 - 9:30 a.m. - Badger State, Faith Christian, Liberty Christian, Maranatha Baptist, and Wyldewood
- There will be locker rooms available to use for changing in but please plan to keep your belongings with your team as the fieldhouse will not be responsible for any lost items.
