



## BAY CITY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL ATHLETICS and COVID-19 INFORMATION

*Updated November 2020 for the 2020-2021 Winter Season*

To all players, coaches, and fans of opposing teams:

Due to the recent inflation of COVID-19 cases in Wisconsin, the athletics staff at Bay City Christian School has made the difficult decision to limit fans in attendance of all athletic events hosted inside Bay City Christian School's facility. The purpose of this decision is to eliminate the congestion of individuals from various parts of the state of Wisconsin. We believe that the limitation of the number of fans will give the spectators, coaches, and athletes a less chance of spreading the coronavirus.

The gymnasium at Bay City Christian School has a very limited maximum capacity as there is only enough room for spectators on one side of the court. For this reason, **the athletics staff at BCCS has decided that the visiting team will be granted two tickets per player during each game.**

*(For example, if a visiting girls' varsity team has 12 players, they will be granted 24 tickets to use for family members and other spectators. Additionally, if the visiting boys' varsity team plays on the same night, the team will have a separate amount of tickets for their game determined by its number of players. Any spectators who do not have tickets for both games are only permitted to attend the game of which he/she possesses tickets.)*

The visiting team may use their tickets in whichever way they wish; however, any unused tickets will be given to the home team for their own use.
