Class A Volleyball State Champions—Maranatha Baptist Academy, Watertown

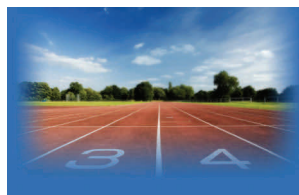
Class B Volleyball State Champions—First Baptist Christian School, Waupaca

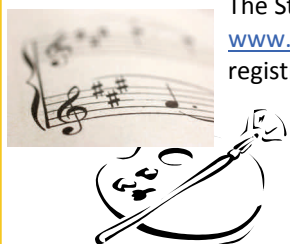
## Great Lakes Educators' Convention
