WACS Membership Registration

We are ready for the 2020-2021 school year registrations to begin! Registrations are due in the WACS office by October 1. There are three forms that must be submitted electronically via email (AACCS Membership Form) or by using the online links (WACS Membership Registration Form and the WACS School Contacts Information). Please contact the WACS office if you need assistance with the forms.

The ability to pay for your membership fees with a credit card or Paypal account is again available. When you submit the WACS

Membership Registration Form it will take you to a Paypal screen where you will choose to checkout as a guest, then you can choose to use a Paypal account or a credit card to pay your registration fees. If you prefer to send a check, it needs to arrive in the WACS office by October 1. Registrations and fees not submitted by October 1 will incur a late fee.

The Wisconsin Association of Christian Schools and the Minnesota Association of Christian Schools will be hosting a virtual Educators' Conference on Friday, October 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. We have created a dedicated website for the conference and we will be using the Whova App to host the conference itself on October 9.

Although we are hoping each school will gather together to watch the sessions, we want to make sure each attendee has access to all the information for October 9 if it is not possible to gather together.

We plan to have 30 live stream workshop options available on October 9, as well as pre-recorded sessions. All the sessions will be made available to view after the conference until November 1, 2020. This will allow paid attendees to watch recorded sessions as they have time over a three week period.
