Congratulations WACS State Basketball Champions

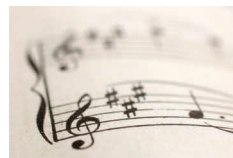

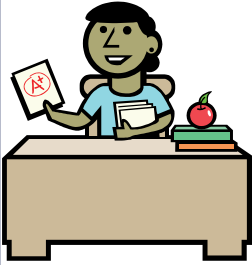


Elementary Competitions are still to come and are being held in Green Bay, LaCrosse, and Menomonee Falls on April 19, 2013.
