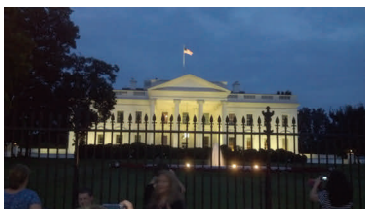

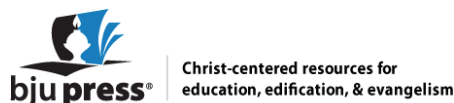
Day at the Capitol
