


WACS Update

From start to finish, our special speakers, representing all 3 branches of government, talked about the importance of Christians being involved in government and how good government reflects God’s principles. Daniel Suhr from Gov. Walker’s office, Lt. Gov. Rebecca Kleefisch, Sen. Dave Craig, Assembly Rep. Jeremy Thiesfeldt and Supreme Court Justice Dan Kelly held the attention of young and old(er) alike. First place went to Bay City Christian School and second to Calvary Baptist School from Menomonee Falls. The day ended with several schools staying for a tour of the capitol and a special heritage tour of the capitol with Ms. Appling.
