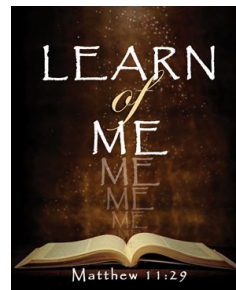
WACS Membership Registration

We are ready for the 2012-13 school year registrations to begin! Registration forms are available in a pdf format on-line at the WACS website. We are again providing a convenient fill-in form, which you may complete on your computer screen, save to your hard drive, then email it to WACS, or print and mail if desired. We hope that this will make the registration process clean and efficient. The forms have been streamlined this year, so please be sure to fill out all the information on the forms that have been sent to you.

Registration fees have remained the same again this year at just \$14 for each student and faculty member. This registration fee gives your school and students all the benefits of being a WACS member as well as including your registration with AACs. **All registrations are due in the WACS office by October 1** in order for your school to be eligible to participate in all the WACS events. 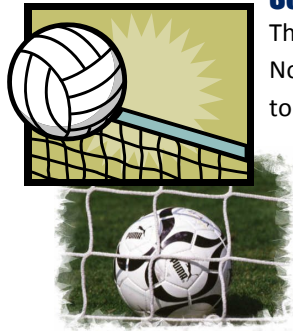

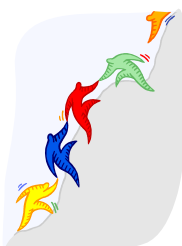
