

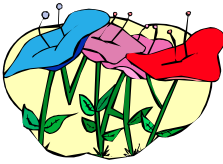

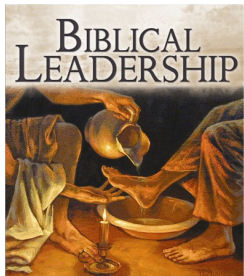


## WACS State Competition in Academics and Fine Arts

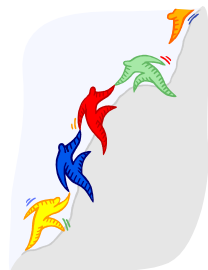
## Educator's Conference
